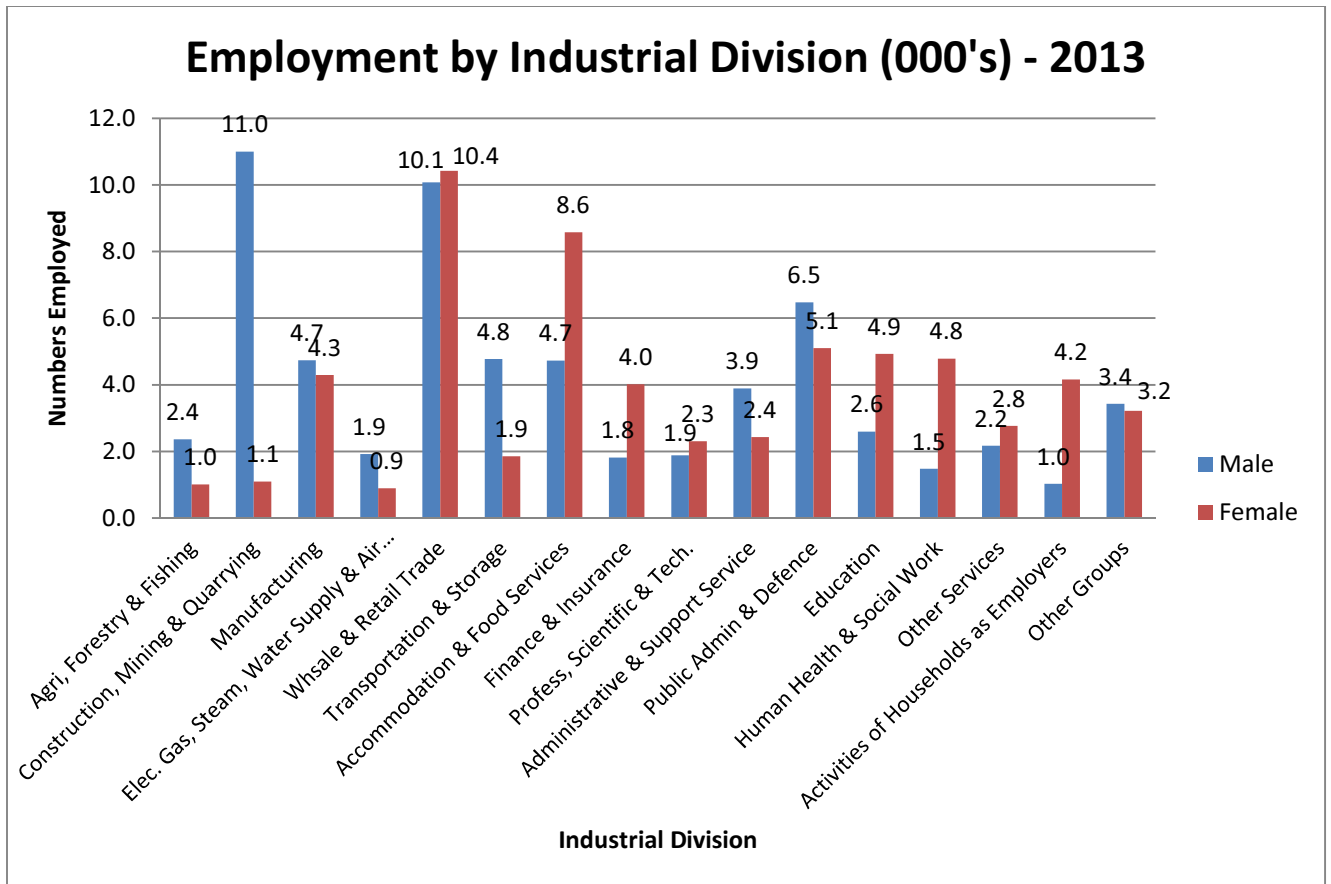

This section seeks to classify employed persons according to broad areas of comparable economic activity. Similar to the analysis of the *employed labour force by occupational grouping*, a gender review of the labour force by industrial division could also be performed.

Females tended to dominate the industries of “Accommodation and Food Services” almost doubling the number of males in this category. There were over twice as many females as there were males in the “Finance & Insurance” field, whilst females almost doubled males employed in the “Education” grouping.

On the other hand, males tended to be prevalent in “Construction” and “Transportation & Storage” services. Males accounted for 91% and 72% of employment in these areas respectively.
