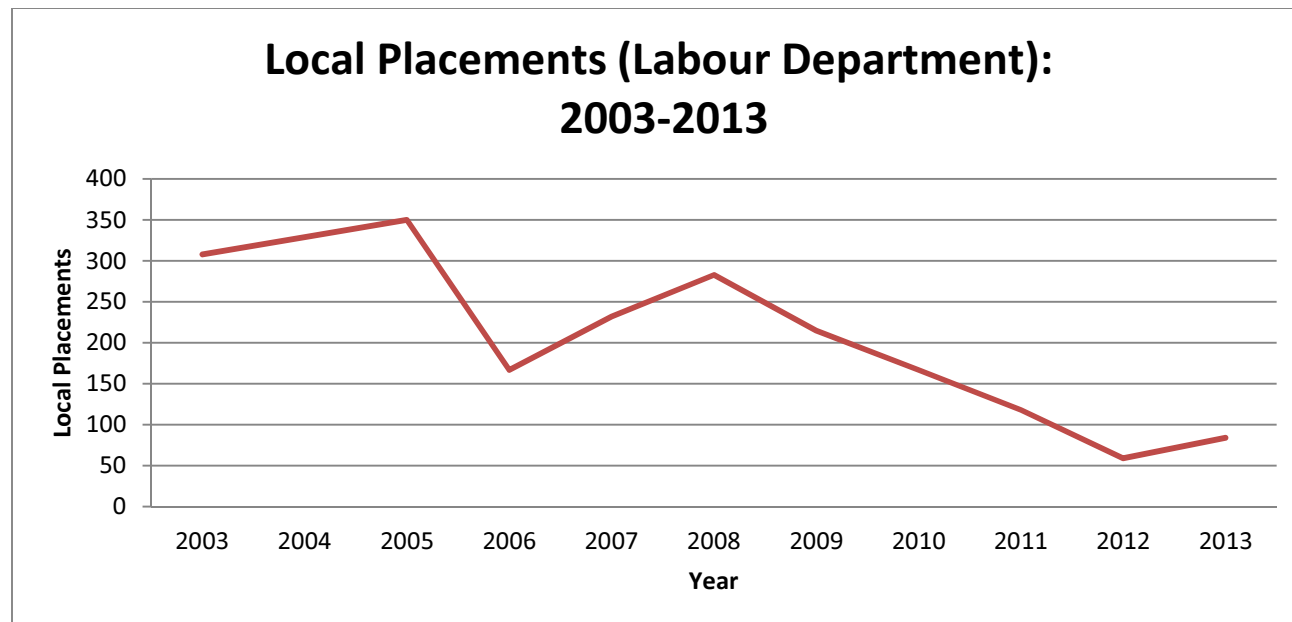

The local placements table highlights the number of registered job seekers at the Labour Department, who have been placed in local occupations. After significant fluctuations were noted between 2003 and 2008, a notable downward trend was identified from 2008 till the end of the review period. A maximum of 350 persons were placed in 2005, whilst in contrast, 59 persons were placed in 2012.

Throughout the period, the majority of placements tended to be for persons in elementary type occupations, as well as shop and service workers. The “Clerks” category was also a significant occupational grouping for the placing of job seekers.
