

1. Why should I register?

By registering you are expressing your interest in working in the Construction Sector.

2. Who is collecting this information?

The Manpower, Research and Statistical Unit (MRSU) of the Ministry of Labour, Social Security and Third Sector.

3. How will this information be used?

This information will be used to determine which areas of the Construction Sector people are most interested in working in.

4. Can I be guaranteed a job if I register?

No. This information is not being used for the purposes of job assignment.

5. Will my personal information be shared with any third-parties?

No. The information will remain in the Ministry.

6. Is there a direct benefit to me registering on the Job Registry?

You will be among the first participants in this data gathering exercise intended to gauge the interest of the public in jobs in the Construction Sector.
